CDT Mini and Rec Concert is at Camden Civic Centre on Wednesday 30th November.

All dancers who have a routine for the concert:

- Toddlers will learn a jazz and a ballet (2 routines)
- Toddler tap students will do a tap routine
- Preschoolers will be doing 3 routines - a jazz, tap and ballet.
- Rec students who are in JFH, lyrical and musical theatre will learn a routine for each of those classes.

Concert is not compulsory BUT you must inform admin if you are not participating in the concert by the end of Week 1, Term 3.

Concert is a wonderful opportunity for all families and friends to watch the students showcase their talent and hard work for the year. All students absolutely love performing and the feeling they get up on stage.

DO PARENTS WATCH?

All parents and guardians of performers remain strictly audience members throughout the show, not allowed in change rooms. We hire backstage and change room helpers to save parents running back and forth. These backstage helpers all have their WWCC and are there to help our superstars get ready. As we continue to grow the number of helpers needed increases as well as the tasks and requirements we ask of them.

This is a day our parents get to kick back, relax and enjoy the show!

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

Your costume fee, concert fee and concert tshirt is already part of your invoice, so the only costs for this time of the years are:

- Your concert footage.

This year, we have hired a brand new videographer and we are so excited!

Concert footage is \$45

- Your ticket to the show! Tickets can be purchased through the trybooking website - link will be sent out 1st November.

Tickets will be \$35 plus booking fee.

HOW LONG DOES IT GO FOR?

The show will run for approximately 70 minutes.

After the show has finished, students will be dismissed group by group to their families/ carers.

END OF YEAR SHOW DETAILS

All Toddlers, pre-schoolers and Rec Stream JFH, Lyrical and Musical Theatre classes will be performing their routines on Wednesday 30th November Camden Civic Centre at 5:30pm.

How the Costumes and Make Up Works:

Costumes are hired from CDT.

The costumes are tried on in class, the first costume will be handed out then the other costumes will be taken to the venue by CDT.

If you wish to buy your costume you can pay the difference to purchase that costume.

Make up is used on stage as the stage lights can drown out the features of the performer and the right make up highlights facial features. After seeking advice from make up artists, CDT will be using a browns colour scheme.

HOW THE SHOW WORKS

Toddlers & Preschoolers and Rec Stream students arrive at 5pm, hair and makeup done, dressed in their first costume (if they have multiple routines)

They will be dropped off at the gallery door.

Doors to the auditorium will open at this time also.

We are hiring backstage helpers (working with children & safety checks will be run on all helpers) to assist the performers in costume change, walking to and from the stage and to ensure the show runs smoothly. This allows all parents and friends to watch the show and to ensure backstage does not get overcrowded, as well as the safety of the children. No one will be allowed backstage without a pass. We receive fantastic feedback regarding how our end of year show runs, we found it creates a calm and exciting atmosphere everybody gets to enjoy - we have included a fee for backstage helpers in your concert fee.

Show starts at 5:30pm.

The show will run for approximately 70 minutes, then afterwards students will be dismissed back to families (dressed in their CDT concert shirt and black shorts).

Students receive a participation medal to take home. Costumes are not taken home, they will remain with CDT staff. There will be a little celebration for our Preschoolers graduating out of the Mini's program and into the next stage of CDT.

HOW THE ROUTINES WORK

Toddlers and Preschoolers are set differently to previous years.

Each class will have their own jazz routine - so please ensure you can commit to your dancers particular lesson day because if they do a make up lesson they will not be practicing their own jazz routine. Specific classes will combine for ballet and tap routines. We are so excited for this!

Here is a breakdown of the routines at the minis and rec concert:

- Thursday and Saturday Preschool Ballet
- Thursday and Saturday Preschool Tap
- Primary Lyrical
- Thursday Primary JFH
- Saturday Primary JFH
- Primary Musical Theatre
- High school Lyrical
- High school JFH

Students will be learning their routines during class time. If they are not taking part in the concert they will still follow along learning the routine and be included in the process just as much as all other students.





FAQ'S

What Will Students Need In Preparation?

Please ensure students have correct footwear and stockings for the right classes. We do not advise waiting until the week before to get all the right materials, as the student will not have prepared in them. If you are not sure, please ask their teachers. For students to prepare correctly for concert they should practice their routine - you can order the music link for \$3, keep their stretching and strengthening constant and try to arrive 15 minutes early for class to warm up to utilize class time.

Please try to keep absences to a minimum, even when the routine is complete as it is a team effort so they can fully prepare for performing onstage with their group.

Who is in the End Of Year Show?

All toddlers, preschoolers and Rec Stream students who do jfh, lyrical and/or musical theatre classes who choose to participate.

If you/your child is not able to participate in our end of year show it is essential you let us know in writing by 25th July as they are group numbers so spacing, patterns and lines depend on the dancers. . Please discuss the importance of commitment to the concert and classes with students so we can run a fantastic show for you!

Why is it Important to Attend Classes?

We understand that some absences are unavoidable due to illness or prior commitments but we appreciate trying to keep absences to a minimum during concert prep time. As these routines are group dances, it is important that all members of the class are there to learn choreography. Each week should be a progression of the routine, to make it the best dance possible to showcase at the show, but if there are constant absences we will have to back track choreography already been taught so we will not be able to move forward - we would hate for any student to go up on stage and be unsure what they have to do! This also makes the dancers aware of the importance of being part of a team, what it means to work together.

Recording the Performance?

We enforce a strict no flash photography or video recording of the end of year show. This is to keep under the child privacy acts so we would appreciate your full cooperation. Confirm your footage order with us ASAP! Unfortunately, if you are seen trying to take photos or record, you will be escorted out of the auditorium.

Who Does Hair and Makeup?

You do! This is the responsibility is on the dancer/ dancers family. We set guidelines and help with tutorials and visual cues. We will be holding a concert makeup tutorial class in Term Four.

What Happens After the Concert?

Dancing is still on for 3 more weeks!

Our 2023 timetable will begin during these weeks - more information will be released at a later date.
